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Indoor Team Formation Parent Guide

General Information

- ❖ Kick City indoor leagues have an eight game season format with games roughly once per week on weeknights and/or weekends. Game days vary by division and season.
- ❖ Dates: **Winter 1 Session:** November-January; **Winter 2 Session:** February-March

Team Organization

- ❖ Team managers will survey families to find out how many players will be playing indoor. **It is very important that you respond promptly to all communications.**
- ❖ Once enough players have responded, your team manager will register the team at Kick City.

Coaching

- ❖ Let your team manager know whether you prefer to have a Pelada coach or a parent coach for your indoor games.
- ❖ If your team wishes to have a Pelada coach, an additional cost of \$200 will be applied to your team account and divided equally amongst the players (average cost of \$20 per player).
- ❖ If your team does not use a Pelada coach, **a parent must be in the box for each game.** The team manager is **not** responsible for coaching, so please be ready to step up and help with this.
- ❖ All parent coaches must be registered with Kick City and included on the team roster.

Payment

- ❖ Team registration fees will be divided equally amongst the players on your team. Please pay your child's portion promptly.
- ❖ Your team manager will open an account at Kick City. You will be able to pay at the Kick City front desk or over the phone (541-744-2255). The team manager is **not** responsible for collecting fees.
- ❖ All players are required to have a current Kick City membership. Individual membership costs are not included in your team account.
- ❖ Your fees must be paid and your player registered with Kick City prior to the first game.
