## Private Training and Small Group Sessions

Pelada FA provides opportunities for players to pursue individual and specialized training with Pelada FA coaches, and for coaches to work with players in a one-on-one or small group setting.

- Purpose:** To provide supplemental and personalized training opportunities for Academy players.
- Format:** Sessions will be one hour in duration (unless otherwise agreed upon), date, time, and place to be decided by the player/player's family and the coach providing the lesson.
- Player Eligibility:** All participating players must be registered members of Pelada Football Academy and current members of OYSA.
- Coach Requirements:** Coaches must hold a minimum U.S. National "F" Certification and be a registered member of the Pelada FA coaching staff in order to run private training or small group sessions for the Academy.
- Fees:** Cost of sessions will be set on a sliding scale, dependent on the number of participants in the session and the certification level of the coach:

<b>1 Player</b>	\$20.00	\$30.00	\$40.00
<b>2 Players</b>	\$30.00	\$40.00	\$50.00
<b>3 Players</b>	\$30.00	\$45.00	\$60.00
<b>4+ Players</b>	\$40.00	\$50.00	\$60.00

- Payments:** All fees must be paid to the Academy (Pelada FA), not directly to the coach. If payments are made in cash on the field, the coach is responsible for issuing a receipt and providing a copy along with cash funds to the registrar, treasurer, or director of the Academy. Parents are encouraged to pay by check and should not make checks out to the coach's name.
- Coach Compensation:** Fees for private training and small group sessions will be paid to the coach monthly with his or her paycheck. If sessions have been run by multiple coaches together, payments will be divided between the coaches. The Academy keeps 10% of fees collected for private training to cover liability, equipment, and administrative costs.
